It is here at one of Nepal's holiest Buddhist sites that you will find Kechara Lounge, the first foreign information centre of the Kechara organisation. Kechara Lounge is a cosy, quiet corner located amidst the bustling rush of Nepalese, Tibetan and foreign pilgrims. With a prime view of the holy stupa, Kechara Lounge provides visitors with a place to relax, acquaint themselves with His Eminence Tsem Tulku Rinpoche's teachings through books and DVDs, and learn more about the KECHARA organisation from one of our friendly volunteers.

Inspired by His Eminence, Kechara Lounge was established in December 2008 when it was confirmed that Kechara would be taking the first-floor shop lot located a mere 10 feet away from the world-famous Boudhanath Stupa.

After extensive renovations, the Lounge opened with much fanfare in February 2009. Since then, operations have been led by Chuah Su Ming. There has been a steady stream of visitors, new and regular, using the lounge to browse through Kechara Media & Publications books, listen to His Eminence's teachings in the chill-out area, learn about Kechara or just relax over a cup of tea.
